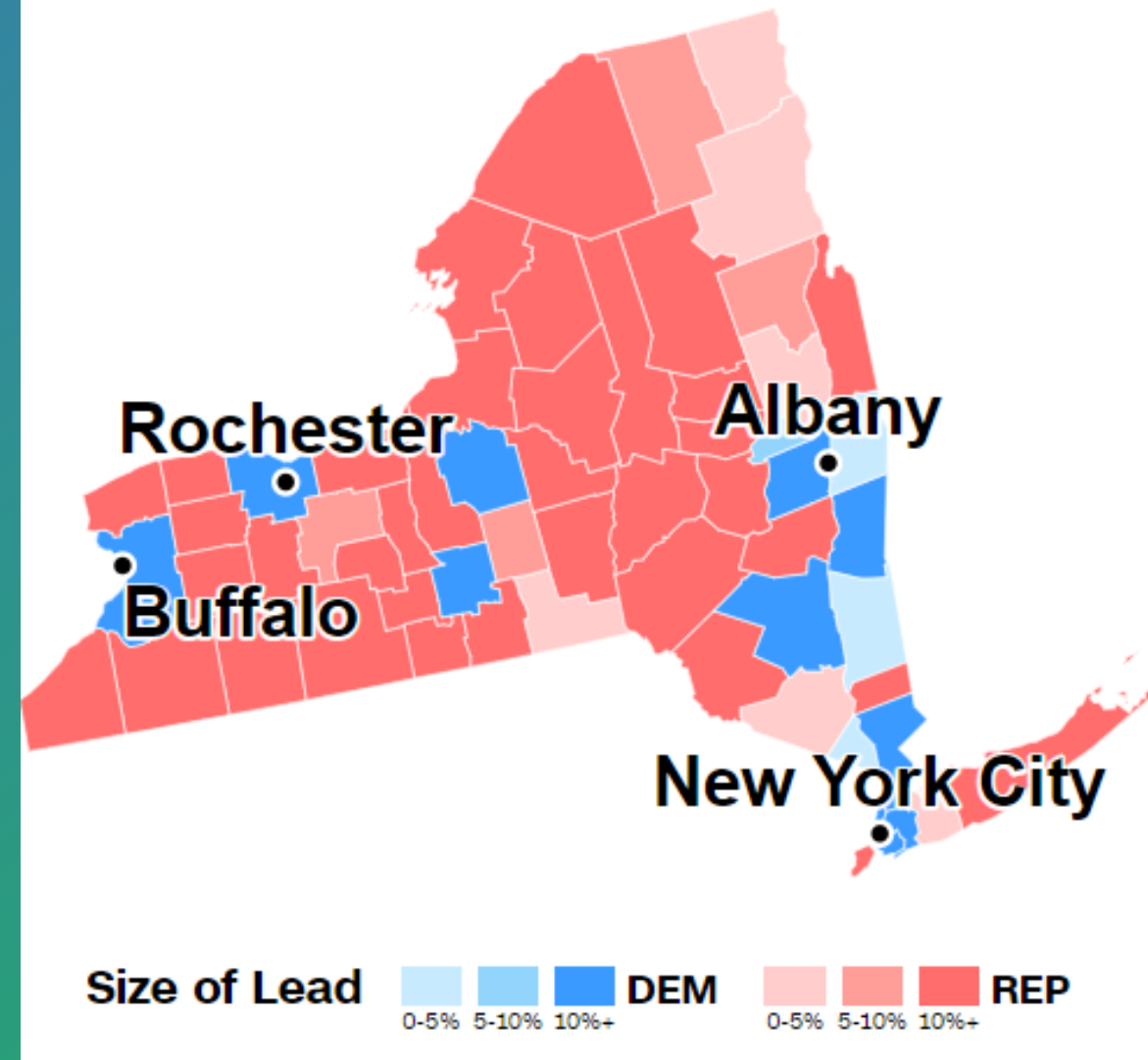
The road to save America goes through New York

Background

In 2022, the New York Congressional maps were redrawn, flipping Congressional Districts 1, 3, 17, and 22 from blue to red. In CD 18, Democrats narrowly held the seat.

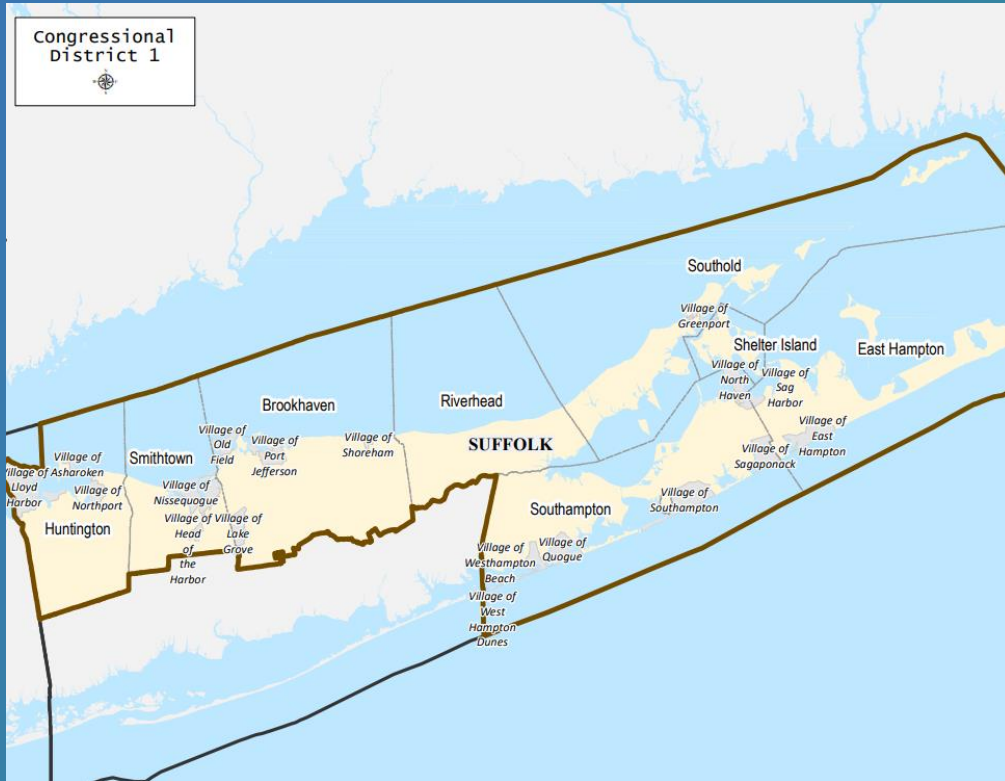
In December of 2023, the New York Court of Appeals ruled that the congressional lines must be redrawn. The deadline for the Independent Redistricting Commission to submit new maps is February 28, 2024.

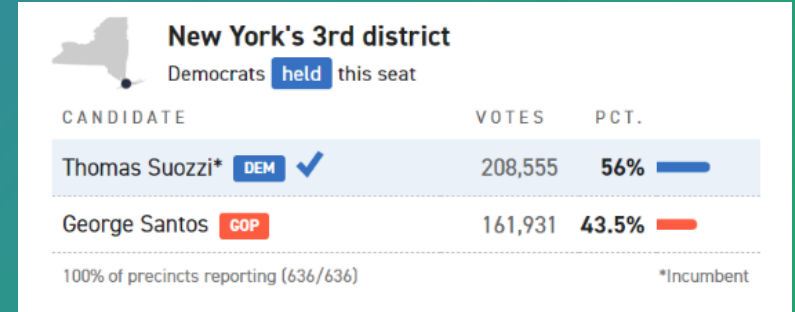

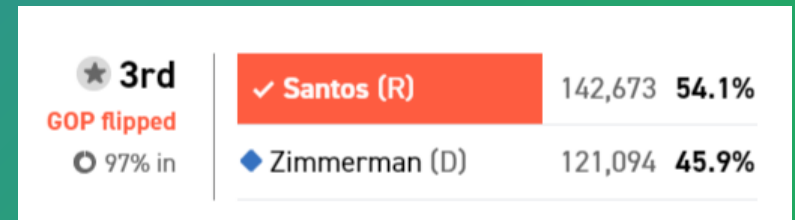

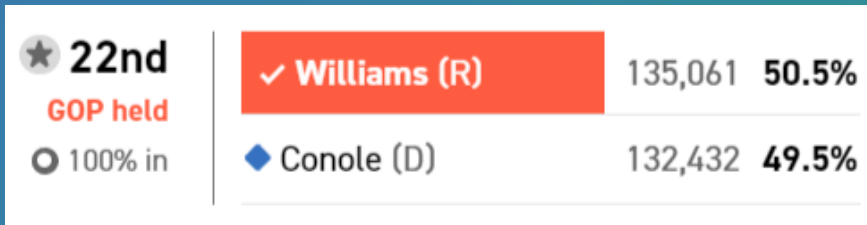

Political Goals for 2024

Types Of Programs AFSCME Will Be Involved In

Convene table of NY affiliates to focus on Congressional campaigns

Convince affiliates (CSEA) to run AFSCME/affiliate coordinated campaigns in Congressional races

Partner with DC 37 to focus on endorsements and state legislative races, and to participate in affiliate table for Congressional race in CD 3

Work with Council 66 to expand capacity (train members), grow political program, make PEOPLE a priority, voter registration, affiliate table in CD 22
